

AN UNCOMMON TRIP TO THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY

PROGRESS THROUGH PRESERVATION'S LEXINGTON, KENTUCKY MOTOR COACH TOUR

Trot off to Blue Grass Country on PTP's trip to Lexington, Kentucky, May 28-30, 2008. You will stay in 19th century Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill, America's largest restored Shaker community and a National Historic Landmark. After touring the village, cruise the Kentucky River on the stern-wheeler riverboat, Dixie Belle. End the day at the village inn with a candlelit dinner of Kentucky and Shaker specialties.

Your first stop on day two is at Blue Grass Trust property Pope Villa, designed in 1810 by Benjamin Latrobe, the "Father of American Architecture". Next, you will see the Henry Clay Estate in Ashland, Clay's home from about 1806 to 1852, another National Historic Landmark and the nearby Mary Todd Lincoln House, built in 1806 which served initially as an inn. Then enjoy a special bus tour of Historic Downtown Lexington. Top off your second day with drinks and dinner at Dudley's Restaurant, located in an 1881 schoolhouse, a fine example of adaptive reuse and also a Blue Grass Trust property.

On your final day, you will experience two of Blue Grass Country's three vices – bourbon and horses (no tobacco though). Your first stop will be at another National Historic Landmark, Woodford Reserve Distillery. Then enjoy lunch at nearby Holly Hill Inn which is on the National Register. After lunch, you'll enjoy a tour of Lexington area horse farms before venturing home. This Lexington trip will inspire us all to recognize and appreciate the elements that contribute to our sense of place, and maintain our commitment to preservation.

The cost for this incredible tour is \$325 for PTP members and \$355 for non-members. Add \$60 for single occupancy. *Membership application forms can be downloaded from the PTP website for those who want to become members.* The tour price includes all transportation, accommodations, meals (except the fast food stops driving to and from Lexington), admissions, tours and tips.

Make reservations with a check to PTP, 465 South Portage Path, Akron, OH 44320. Space is limited so send your deposit of \$150 right away to reserve your place. Your deposit is 100% refundable until April 24, 2008. Final payment is due by May 5, 2008.
